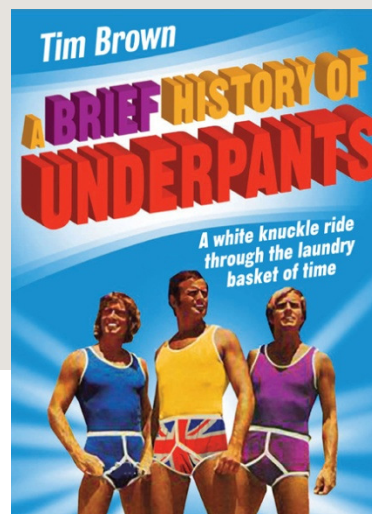


Title	A Brief History of Underpants
